

• A Tale of Two Composers and FQ Syndicate #6

A Tale of Two Composers, our innovative commissioning project, aims to raise \$50,000 for the commissioning, creative development and recording of two unique works by Melody Eötvös and Rishin Singh. Embracing the unprecedented boldness inherent in this project, we have adopted it as our central marketing message for fundraising, drawing inspiration from a renowned literary masterpiece that resonates with the majority of our donors. Julian Burnside's \$10,000 pledge for Melody's commission has jump-started the initiative.

In early November, we unveiled FQ Syndicate #6 as a part of the project to commission Rishin Singh, targeting a fundraising goal of \$10,000. The syndicate started with David Kirkham's donation, and in less than a week after the campaign's launch, we've garnered five more contributions from Nicholas Garnham, Linda Herd, John and Susan Warburton, Elise Callander, and Brad and Maggie Robinson,

reaching a total of \$5,817.50 out of \$10,000 (58%). The syndicate completion is expected by 2023 year-end.

On November 28, we launched the A Tale of Two Composers campaign, soliciting funds for creative development and recording production costs on top of artist commissions. We're also actively seeking match funders, exploring potential contributions from Michael Aquilina (Wilma Smith's connection), and Reg Holloway and Ian Dickson (Mary Vallentine's connection) who have attended our latest post-concert supper on 30 October with Mary. To maximise outreach, we'll utilise e-newsletters, social media, and personalised emails for targeted prospects.

• Program 3 post-concert supper at Blondie Bar

On October 30, the concluding day of our 2023 subscription concert series 3, we held our post-concert dinner in Blondie Bar, Melbourne Recital Centre, to express gratitude to our supporters as usual. During the dinner, we were delighted to host guests including existing donors Linda Herd and Julie Kantor, and first-time attendees/prospects Reg Holloway and Ian Dickson. Mary Vallentine and Sarah Hunt also graced the occasion, attending the dinner in their capacities as the incoming Board Chair and Board member of FQ. The guests thoroughly enjoyed their time interacting with our musicians and Board members, and composer Maria Grenfell.

Open rehearsal

FQ leverages its open rehearsals as unique and intimate experiences, providing supporters with the opportunity to engage behind the scenes. On October 14, we held an open rehearsal at the Library at the Dock in preparation for the third subscription concert of 2023. Seven dedicated Syndicate #5 supporters were extended invitations, and we were delighted to have Dr. Garry Joslin and Prof. Dimity Reed AM in attendance. We were also pleased to have several teachers from the Methodist Ladies' College join us at the rehearsal, expressing interest in potential future partnerships.

Donor Spotlight

The FQ Donor Spotlight, featured as a dedicated section within our enews and on our website, serves as a platform to celebrate our crucial supporters and share their enthusiasm. In our recent Donor Spotlight, we had the privilege of interviewing Sam and Elizabeth Golding. This dynamic duo conveyed their deep affection and encouragement for the quartet. Their heartfelt message was published in the November EDM and displayed on our webpage. Our forthcoming Spotlight is scheduled for March 2024.

Preparation of 2024 annual Fifth String event

FQ's 2024 activity commences in February with the Emerge program, and we've opted to kick off our 2024 Fifth String annual event earlier next year. The planning and initiation of this event is well underway, and we've taken the first steps by consulting with one of our loyal major donors, Faye Goldsmith. Graciously, Faye has agreed to lend her house for the private event on February 23. With her background as a musician and experience in organising private concerts at her residence, Faye brings valuable insights to the table. Currently, we are in the process of ironing out logistics and catering details. Following this, we will proceed to draft the invitations and compile the guest list which will include all Fifth String members not invited to the February 24 event (outlined below).

Special major donor event February 24 Phil Rounsevell and Nelson Estrella
 Phil and Nelson are major supporters of other Australian arts organisations and have indicated that they would very much like to host an event February 24 (4pm-6:30pm) focussed on finalising The

As part of the two-year funding support from the City of Melbourne, we have collaborated with The Mac.Robertson Girls' High School on a cross-media project. In this project, students were given the creative empowerment to design posters for FQ's third subscription concert in 2023. Zoe dedicated six hours to working with 45 students to develop innovative concepts. Two of their outstanding works were chosen for 100 A0 prints and prominently displayed across the City of Melbourne for the fortnight commencing October 16. Additionally, all the student works were projected as a backdrop during the two October 2023 concerts at the Primrose Potter Salon, Melbourne Recital Centre.
