PURPOSE:

To provide the Board an update on the financial impact resulting from COVID-19 on Flinders Quartet Inc.

SUMMARY:

- 1. The updated 2020 Forecast presents a net surplus of \$2,099 including all known impacts of COVID-19. This is a \$94 improvement from the previous financial report.
- 2. FQ's JobKeeper application has not been confirmed; the impact is excluded.
- 3. Philanthropy target amounts included is \$25,000.
- 4. The third concert program remains in the Forecast with a net positive impact of \$7,806. Plans are underway to deliver remaining activity and satisfy all grant obligations through online platform delivery.
- 5. While cashflow is currently extremely positive and meet requirements in the short term further work is required to ensure going concern assessments will be met at year end.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

6. Philanthropy amounts as outlined in the table below. Private donations received to date are \$40,000 (\$5,000 greater than prior report).

Confirmed Trusts and Foundations amounts include; Robert Salzer Foundation \$5,000, Cybec \$20,000, Playking \$40,000 and Helen Macpherson Smith Trust \$25,000. Where possible new grants are being used to support existing planned activity however Playking and HMST grants have resulted in increased expenditure which is included in the Forecast.

A Philanthropy target of \$25,000 is remaining with 1 grant application awaiting an outcome.

7. Government funding amounts outlined in the table below. Discussion with funders has confirmed that digital/online activity will satisfy all performance criteria of grants and suitable activity is scheduled. Creative Victoria grant of \$10,000 is now included in this category it is likely to be directed towards regional touring/mentoring activity and not as similar in nature to other COVID-19 support.
