- End of year concert in Gippsland with 2 FQ members
- Zoe to travel to Mildura in September as AD to work with 3 ensembles
- Zoe to support John in online coaching where needed as AD (up to 6 sessions online)

John needs some support in being able to sustain the mentoring for the ensembles. The 6 sessions allocated to AD salary may not be needed.

In 2024, a large part of our John Noble activity will be the "Art Is" festival in Horsham, bringing together musicians from Horsham and Mildura (and potentially Bendigo) and connecting with Resonance String Orchestra

John reported that Zoe's in-person coaching in Mildura in 2023 had significant impact and has requested the same in 2024.

The end of year concert is in Gippsland and will include 2 FQ members allowing space for other professional musicians to take part.

Itet has also been connected with suitable composers who have applied but not been successful in gaining a place in our composer programs.

The string community of Resonance is enthusiastic and creative, and produces concerts with deep meaning and thought; they are perfectly aligned to FQ. In 2024, the quartet program will focus on one string quartet and it will be on a project basis of intensives to minimise burnout and ensure momentum. Resonance and FQ are in discussions about a mini festival of concerts in Castlemaine in 2025, culminating in the Mendelssohn Octet performed with the Castlemaine Chamber Players. Resonance has also been connected with suitable composers who have applied but not been successful in gaining a place in our composer programs.

Comments

- Bringing students into the FQ 1pm concerts is well appreciated and we will trial supplementing this with resources in advance.
- Open rehearsal and discussion with students at Footscray is well appreciated offering this to VCASS in 2024.
- Ringwood Secondary College is at maximum capacity in their activity already. A strong music program that leaves little time for the teachers to contemplate something new.
- The project with MacRob in 2023 was Shostakovich specific. There is the possibility of pursuing a similar project but perhaps more realistically in 2025.
