## **COVID-19 REVISION NOTES**

- Budget revisions based on cancelled and amended activity from April to June 2020; July 2020 onwards remains as previously budgeted (e.g. income and expenses relating to Composer Development Program and Monash projects in August, and October subscription series concerts, remain as is). We acknowledge this is an ever-changing situation, and further amendments are likely.
- INCOME
  - Presented concert fees reduced from \$50,000 to \$32,000 due to cancelled concerts
  - Ticket revenue reduced from \$26,500 to \$17,800 due to cancellation of MRC, Montsalvat and Collins Street June 2020 concerts, and Sydney August concert (this includes \$800 from MRC's Performer Support Fund in lieu of the June 17 copresentation concert revenue)
  - Government funding remains as originally budgeted, however \$20,000 remains 'at risk' from Australia Council application (outcome to be known May/June)
  - Private donations reduced by \$50,000 to \$85,000; \$26,340 received YTD meaning \$58,660 is still to be sought
  - o Trust and Foundation revenue remains as originally budgeted, with \$25,000 of the

\$55,000 total received YTD, and waiting to hear about funding application outcomes from Gandel Foundation (\$20,000) and Besen Family Foundation (\$30,000)

- A new Government stimulus revenue line has been added, with \$20,000 included. Three potential avenues for government COVID-19 support have been identified and will be pursued:
  - PAYG withholding credit; we anticipate \$20,000 to be received between April and September/October (included in budget)
  - Business Victoria Business Support Fund \$10,000 (not yet included in budget)
  - JobKeeper payments at \$1500/fortnight per eligible employee (not yet included in budget). Based on the information currently available, FQ organisation is likely to be eligible but TBC; most but probably not all FQ employees likely to be eligible but TBC.
- The following grant applications have been submitted (or will soon be) however this income and most expenses relative to each project <u>have not</u> been included in this budget:
  - Creative Victoria / Touring Victoria \$17,000 for regional touring (contact has been made outlining FQ's changes to this project given COVID-19)
  - HMST \$25,000 for organisational evaluation (contact has been made outlining FQ's changes to this project given COVID-19)
  - Australia Council Resilience Fund up to \$20,000 (focus of FQ's application will be around investigation and trialling of technology to enable remote rehearsal and development process)
  - Monash #AloneTogether commission \$1,000 for digital presentation or performance project
- SALARIES
  - Musician and administration salaries and on costs remain to be paid at 0.31FTE rates, as previously budgeted
  - Reduction in extra 'casual' work budgeted, either absorbed into salary or cancelled. Some casual work remains budgeted but will be regularly reviewed and reduced as appropriate/needed.
  - Per diums reduced in line with interstate touring cancellations
- EXPENSES
  - Increase in equipment costs: investment in microphones and iPad adapters to improve sound quality for digital delivery of JNQP mentoring, and in anticipation of online development and rehearsal sessions
  - Reduction in concert expenses resulting from cancellation of June concerts
  - \$800 reduction in development costs, with June event cancelled
  - Reduction in marketing expenditure in the areas of paid advertising and filming/documentation; further \$5,000-\$7,000 reduction in these areas are possible if essential
  - Reduction in travel expenses due to tour cancellations, border closures, etc
